**ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR SECOND INTERIM FEE APPLICATION
FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 2015 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2015
FILED BY KAPILAMUKAMAL, CPA'S**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on November 13, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. upon the Second Interim Application For Allowance And Payment Of Compensation For Services Rendered And Reimbursement Of Expenses To Accountant To The Chapter 7 Trustee For The Period Of April 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015. The Application seeks the following amounts for the time period covered: fees \$290,973.80 and costs \$3,947.89, for a total of \$294,921.69, for which no previous awards have been made.

The Court has examined the Application and has considered the arguments of the Applicant, his counsel and other counsel appearing at the hearing. The Court finds that sufficient

notice to creditors and other parties in interest has been given.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. KapilaMukamal is hereby allowed the sum of \$290,973.80 as compensation for services rendered to the estate and expenses of \$3,947.89 for a total award of \$294,921.69 for interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses through September 30, 2015. The Trustee is authorized to pay at this time the sum of \$294,921.69.

2. The entry of this Order is without prejudice to the right of the Applicant to make application to the Court at a future date for payment of any amounts allowed as set forth in paragraph 1 but not paid at this time and any holdbacks.

3. In allowing the foregoing compensation, the Court has considered all of the factors that govern the reasonableness of such compensation as set forth in 11 U.S.C. Sections 330 and 331 and in in re George Schumann Tire & Battery Company, 908 F.2d 874 (11th Cir. 1990), and in In re First Colonial Corporation, 544 F.2d 1291 (5th Cir. 1977).
