**AGREED ORDER GRANTING MAATSCHAP QI
COLLECTIEF'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM THE
AUTOMATIC STAY TO PURSUE LITIGATION IN
BELGIUM**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on negative notice on *Maatschap QI Collectief's* ("MQIC") *Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay to Pursue Litigation in Belgium* (the "Motion") [ECF# 927]. The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the Motion, that consideration of the Motion is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and that venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. The Court has considered the Motion, the Response filed by the Trustee [ECF# 944], has reviewed the docket, and notes that no other objections or responses to the Motion were filed in the time prescribed by

the Local Rules, that the form of this Order has been agreed to by the Trustee, and holds that the Motion should be GRANTED as set forth herein. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS**:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The automatic stay is lifted so that MQIC may commence litigation in Belgium against the Strategic Life Settlement Fund and related entities. MQIC may not, however, allege that it or the investors owned any of the estate's insurance policies, including policies sold by the estate or settled in litigation, or that it or the investors are pursuing any litigation on behalf of the estates.
