ORDER GRANTING TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO MODIFY CERTAIN NOTICE, CASE MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the 24th day of November, 2014 at 9:30 a.m., in West Palm Beach, Florida, upon the *Trustee's Motion to Modify Certain Notice, Case Management and Administrative Procedures* [ECF No. 937] (the "Motion"). The Court, having considered the Motion and the argument of counsel, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, does thereupon

ORDER as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Procedures Order¹ is modified to provide that service of pleadings by first class, U.S. Mail be made only to those creditors who have filed proofs of claims and those interested

parties who have filed notices of appearance or requests for service.

3. The Trustee shall continue to post substantive pleadings, notices and orders entered on the website (www.CLSFTrustee.com) for public viewing by all foreign investors and other parties in interest until further order of this Court, and shall continue to provide electronic notice to those creditors and interested parties who have consented to service electronically.

4. Any party in interest, including Foreign Investors (i) who receives first class, U.S. Mail service; and (ii) who has not previously consented to electronic service in these cases that now wishes to consent to receive service by electronic mail shall contact counsel for the Trustee, Leslie Gern Cloyd at lcloyd@bergersingerman.com, to request notice by electronic mail. Such a request shall constitute consent to service by electronic mail of any and all pleadings and other documents filed in these cases and any and all pleadings and other documents filed in any adversary proceeding filed in these cases, including service of process, for all purposes. On and after the date of such consent, the consenting party shall be served with all appropriate documents and pleadings by electronic mail, provided, however, that such party may be served by any other appropriate method in addition to electronic mail.

5. All other terms and conditions as set forth in the Procedures Order shall remain in full force and effect.
