With regard to the fees set forth in paragraphs 10.1 and 10.2 of the Servicing Agreement, these fees are revised by the fee of \$950.00 set forth in Appendix 1 to the Servicing Agreement.

3. The Trustee is authorized to retain the services of Litai Assets, LLC ("Litai"), pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in the Servicing Agreement, and Litai is authorized to perform the services pursuant to the terms of the Servicing Agreement.

4. The parties are directed to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the Servicing Agreement, and the Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the terms thereof.
