PECK SHOULD NOT BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT FOR HER WILLFUL FAILURE TO OBEY THIS COURT'S ORDER [ECF# 61]; (II) GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION (A) FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY DEBORAH C. PECK SHOULD NOT BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT FOR HER WILLFUL FAILURE TO OBEY THIS COURT'S ORDER, (B) TO STRIKE MOTION AND AMENDED MOTION TO DISMISS PETITIONING CREDITORS' INVOLUNTARY PETITION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY DEBORAH C. PECK SHOULD NOT BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT FOR HER WILLFUL FAILURE TO OBEY THIS COURT'S ORDER [ECF# 63 MAIN]; AND (III) RESOLVING COUNT I, III AND IV OF ADVERSARY COMPLAINT, ENTERED ON JANUARY 22, 2013 IN ADVERSARY NO.: 12-01889-EPK**

**THIS MATTER** came before the Court upon the *Agreed Motion to Include Additional Alter Ego Entities as "Alter Ego Entities" as Defined By This Court's Order (I) Granting in Part*

*and Denying in Part Interim Trustee's Emergency Motion for Entry of an Order to Show Cause Why Deborah C. Peck Should Not Be Held in Contempt of Court For Her Willful Failure to Obey This Court's Order [ECF# 61]; (II) Granting in Part and Denying in Part Supplemental Motion (A) for Entry of an Order to Show Cause Why Deborah C. Peck Should Not Be Held in Contempt of Court for Her Willful Failure to Obey This Court's Order, (B) to Strike Motion and Amended Motion to Dismiss Petitioning Creditors' Involuntary Petition for Entry of an Order to Show Cause Why Deborah C. Peck Should Not Be Held in Contempt of Court for Her Willful Failure to Obey This Court's Order [ECF# 63 Main]; and (III) Resolving Count I, III and IV of Adversary Complaint, Entered on January 22, 2013 in Adversary No.: 12-01889-EPK (the "Motion") [ECF# 568] filed by the Trustee, Deborah C. Menotte. The Court, having considered the Motion, having noted the agreement of Deborah C. Peck as to the relief requested in the Motion, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, does thereupon*

**ORDER** as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Joher Family Insurance Trust UA DTD 9/10/2010 and the Joher Family Insurance Trust shall be included among the Alter Ego Entities (as defined in the Motion).
3. Joher Family Insurance Trust UA DTD 9/10/2010 and the Joher Family Insurance Trust shall be subject to this Court's *Amended Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction* [ECF# 40, Adversary Proc. No. 12-01889-EPK].
4. The *Order Granting Trustee's Second Amended Motion for Substantive Consolidation of the Jointly Administered Bankruptcy Estates* [ECF# 561] is amended to include Joher Family Insurance Trust UA DTD 9/10/2010 and Joher Family Insurance Trust as Alter Ego Entities.
